- this is a puzzle quilt, no instructions, only hints

fabric:

background.....	8.5" x 11"
fence [7 pieces].....	8"x8"
nails [10 pieces].....	2" x 2"
roof.....	6" x 5"
birdhouse base.....	9" x 12"
pole.....	3" x 4"
entrance hole & perch.....	2" x 3"
flower.....	3" x 3"
flower center.....	2" x 2"
flower stem.....	2" x 2"
leaves.....	4" x 4"
welcome.....	9" x 2"

fusible web (17").....	11"x17"
stabilizer.....	8.5" x 11"

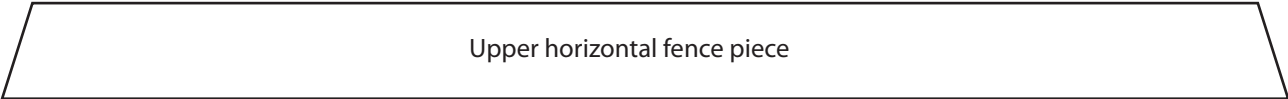
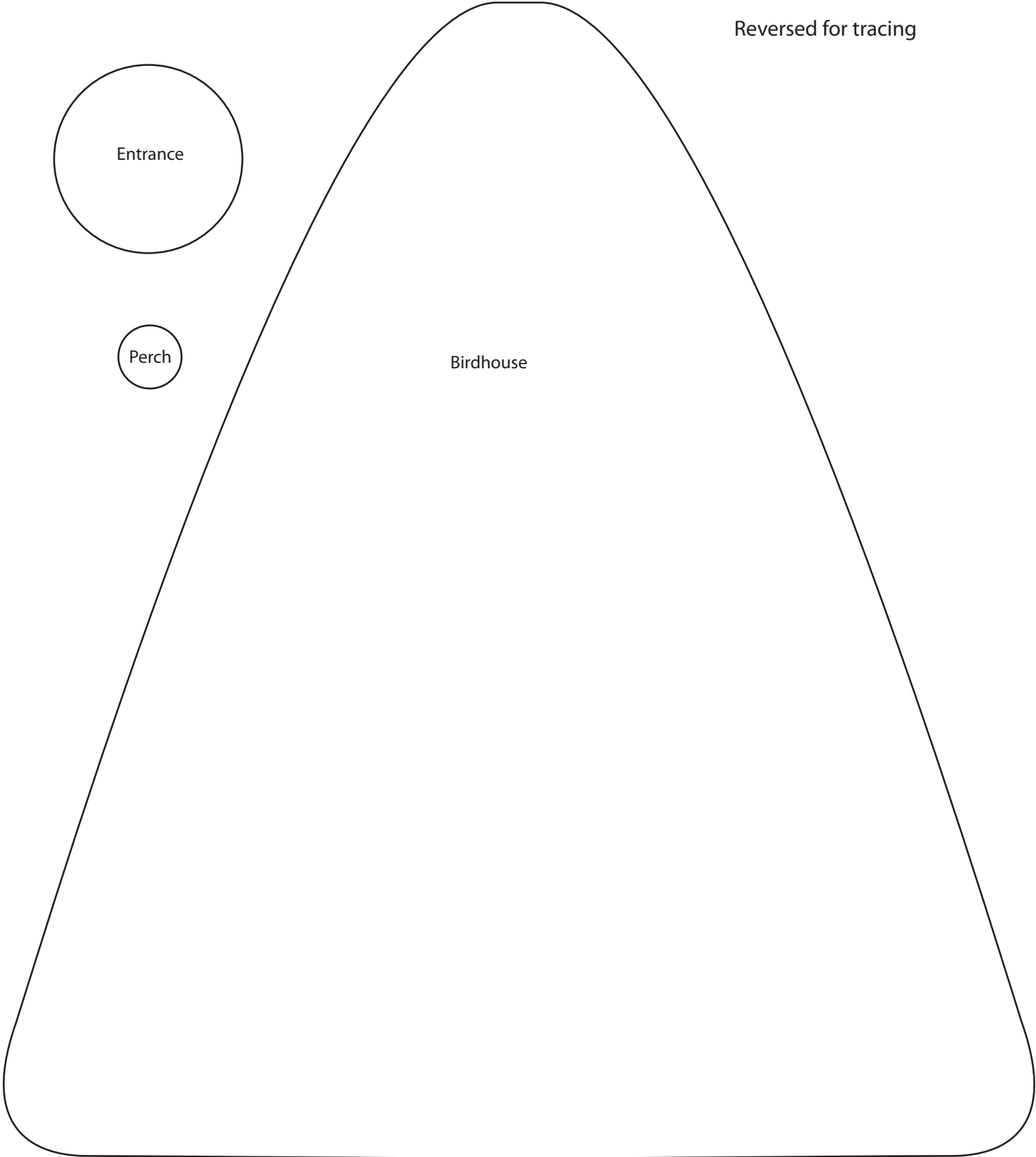
If you are not comfortable to apply the word Welcome, leave it off the block.

Positioning Diagram & Hints



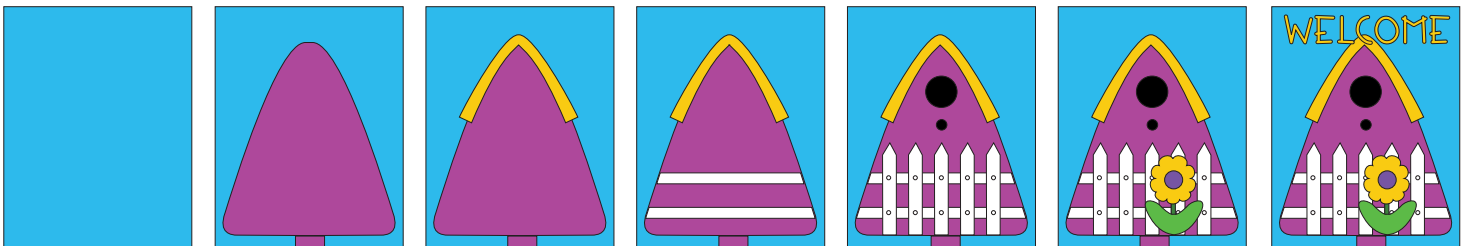
General look if needle turn

satin stitch used to applique

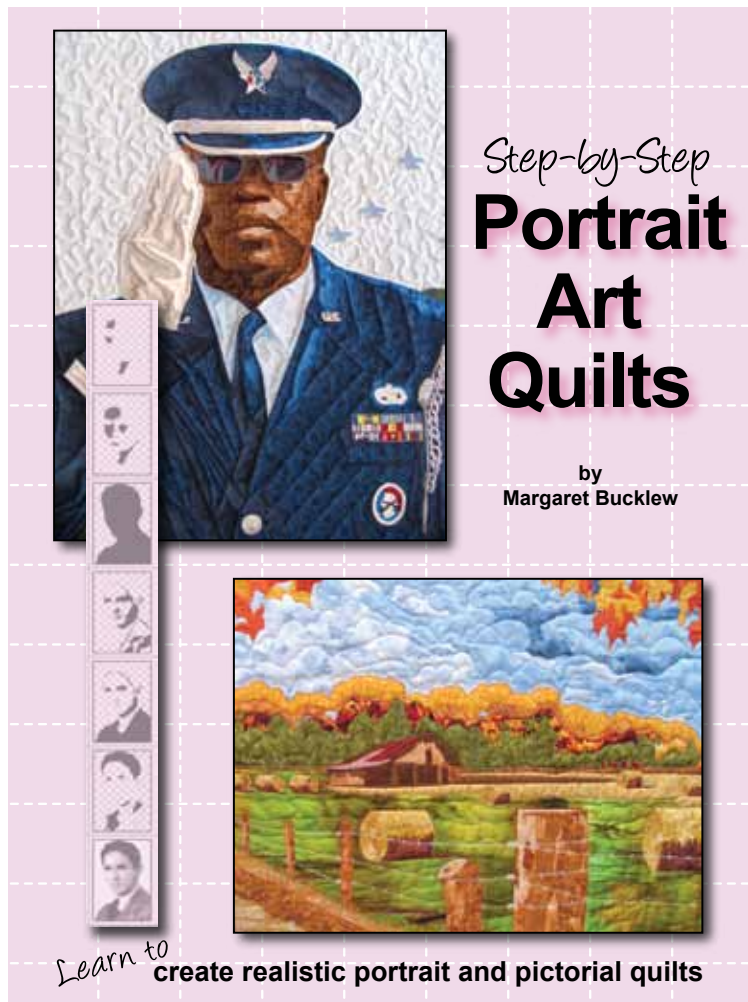

Hints:

- trace applique pieces onto paper backed fusible web
- press traced pieces to wrong side of fabric, when cool, cut along traced lines
- place in position as indicated (or your preference), press
- place stabilizer behind the block prior to applique
- to secure pieces, use blanket stitch, narrow zig zag stitch or satin stitch
