- trace applique pieces onto paper backed fusible web
- press traced pieces to wrong side of fabric, when cool, cut along traced lines
- place in position as indicated (or your preference), press
- place stabilizer behind the block prior to applique
- to secure pieces, use blanket stitch, narrow zig zag stitch or satin stitch
